



CHECKLIST OF DOCUMENTS & EVIDENCE FOR ACCIDENT OR INJURY CLAIM

Whether you are actively pursuing a legal claim or are merely considering one, below are the items to keep handy in order to help your attorney best present your case.

Additionally, when you attend your first meeting with your attorney, it is helpful to bring the following items with you.

Photos/videos/audio of:

- Scene of accident
- Injuries
- Property damage
- People present at scene of accident
- Road or accident site conditions

Official Reports

- Police reports
- Reports by other law enforcement agencies
- Accident reconstruction reports
- Private investigation reports
- 911 dispatch call recordings

Physical Evidence

- Damaged items
- Clothing worn during accident

Statements/Notes

- Witness statements
- Victim statements
- Your notes or journal

Medical Reports

- Doctor examination reports
- Specialist reports

Insurance

- Your insurance card(s)
- Other party's insurance information
- Correspondence to/from insurance companies

Expenses

- Medical bills
- Repair invoices
- Repair estimates
- Payment receipts (medical, vehicle, other property)

Lost Income

- W-2 statements
